**Morning Drop Off-**PES school doors open at 7:30 a.m. on school days. Prior to 7:30, our building does not have staff on duty for supervision. This is just a friendly reminder since this has been occurring more often. This is a safety concern and we thank you for your understanding.

**PARCC State Mandated Testing-**Our school will take the <u>PARCC test from April 9-17<sup>th</sup></u>. All students in 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade will be assessed on English Language Arts and Mathematics. 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will also be assessed in Science. All assessments will be taken on Chromebooks. Please do not schedule appointments during these dates if it can be avoided. Parent requests for extended travel will not be approved. **Lunch Balances-**Thank you for paying close attention to your lunch bills. If you are uncertain of your child's balance, you may check it on Skyward or call Kim in the office.

**Flu Season-**This flu season has been one for the ages and we are just now getting into the actual flu and cold season. In order to avoid spreading the flu, please follow the guidelines if your child becomes ill. Students must be fever free WITHOUT medication and may not have vomited for 24 hours before returning to school. We know this is tough for working parents, but we are concerned about spreading illnesses to other students. A "fever" for school is considered 99.5 or higher. Also, if your student has a fever while at school and gets picked up, they should not return to school the next day. Thank you for helping PES stay healthy!
