Immunizations need to be turned in to the office prior to the new school year. If you want to get ahead and begin planning for next school year, the following items are needed to register for school. Kindergarten students needs a physical, up to date shots, eye exam (from an optometrist), and dental exam. 2nd graders need a dental exam. 6th grade needs a physical, up to date shots (Tdap, Varicella #2, and Meningiococcal #1), and a dental exam. All students who plan to play sports need an up to date physical. Sports physicals are not approved for the physicals needed in K, 6th, or 9th grades. They have to be on the approved schools physical form by the DHS, not the IHSA. They will still count for both the school and sport physical, but it has to be on the correct form.
